1) on my fuse panel cover (from side of the dash) it NOTE: "When equipped with power locks without keyless entry, install 30A fuse. When equipped with power locks and keyless entry, install relay." 2) My Silverado is a LS, has power door lock but NO keyless remote option. So which fuse I should replaced with 30A?

Last week I noticed that my retained accessory power (RAP) feature is no longer retaining accessory power. As soon as I turn off my ignition, everything shuts off...No radio and no power windows. Cant find any info on this in the manual or on this site. Anyone know what is ...

The Retained Accessory Power System allows selected accessory circuits, such as radios or power windows, to remain powered when the ignition switch is turned off. These accessory circuits will remain "live" until the system grounding relay is activated.

So I am upgrading the radio in my 2011 Tahoe. Wiring in the Pioneer replacement was pretty dang straight forward. But when trying to power up everything, nothing was turning on. I have a good ground, and good constant on power (yellow) 12.8v truck off and 14.6 truck on. I am getting no switched on power what so ever....

So I do not know where to connect the power wire from my aftermarket stereo. It did come with the constant power connected just not the accessory switch. This seems to be the consensus on the internet for the factory wiring: Radio Battery Constant 12v+ Wire: Red/White Radio Accessory Switched 12v+ Wire: Dark Green Radio Ground Wire: Black/White

When I shut off the ignition switch, the dash/radio stayed lit so I then opened the door and again got crazy flashing - closed the door and dash/radio are still lit (radio can be turned on). I played a few more times trying to lock/unlock doors open and closed but nothing seemed to shut down the system.

Troubleshooting Common Issues with Retained Accessory Power. Retained Accessory Power (RAP) is a feature that allows certain automotive accessories, such as radios and heated seats, to remain powered after the vehicle has been shut off. This feature can be incredibly convenient for drivers, but it can also cause problems due to its complexity.

There have been many questions as to where to locate RAP (Retained Accessory Power) on the NBS trucks. First let me say thanks to heymccall for all the valuable information that allowed this write-up to happen. RAP is available to us in the MBEC (Mid-Bussed Electrical Connector) located behind the instrument panel to the left of the brake pedal.

I have a problem with the RAP (retained accessory power) on my 2005 Colorado. When I shut the truck off and open the driver side door the radio does not shut off. The passenger side switch still works. Is this a common problem :?:

Every car features an accessory system that's connected to the circuits. The accessory circuits include power windows, radios, stereos, and others. The retained accessory power system helps these accessories to stay on even when the car ignition is turned off. The accessories can be active for more than 600 seconds after switching the ...

That circuit does not use a fuse. It is powered by a circuit breaker labeled &quot;ACCSRY PWR&quot;, on the yellow wire. It is in the box under the dash on the driver's side but it sounds like you have a window switch that is out here is a guide to help you confirm the issue.

I have a 2018 Chevrolet Malibu, when I shut the car off 50 % of the time the radio will stay on for 10 minutes

because of the retained accessory power. But the other 50% of the time when I shut the car off the radio will go off for about 10-12 seconds, also the chimes will chime and then the radio will come back on for 10 minutes.
