What is a power and systems approach?

This chapter offers a theoretical sketch of the nature and dynamics of change as portrayed so far in this book. This is a methodology of sorts, which this chapter refers to as a 'power and systems approach' (PSA). The PSA is a theory of change, meant to locate a programme, project, or campaign within a wider analysis of how change comes about.
