



# Backup power for wink hub

Does the Wink Hub 2 have a battery backup?

The Wink Hub 2 can connect to your local Wi-Fi network (2.4 or 5GHz), or via Ethernet. Unlike the SmartThings hub, the Wink Hub lacks a battery backup, but if the power to the hub goes, chances are most other smart home devices you own will lose power, too. Getting the Wink Hub 2 up and running is pretty straightforward.

Does a wink Smart Hub have a battery backup system?

The wink smart hub also has no battery backup system, which means that your entire smart home could be rendered useless after a power outage if you are not careful. Not to mention, when the power does return, everything will need to reboot and hopefully reconnect to all devices without issue.

Plug in the power and Ethernet, download the app to your iPhone or Android device, and then follow the setup instructions in the app. In all, it took less than 5 minutes to connect the hub to the app. Next, you have to connect other smart home devices to the Hub 2 through the app.

The battery takes 24 hours to become fully charged but you can still use your hub in the meantime.

The Wink 2 comes with a power port and an Ethernet port that you can use to connect it to the Wi-Fi. Unlike SmartThings Hub, the Wink 2 does not come with a USB port. It works with an In-wall AC power source, and it does not have a battery backup. That means in case of a blackout; the device will be offline. Connectivity

Finicky when it comes to the size and shape of your smart hub? While both the Wink Hub 2 and Samsung SmartThings come in a white enclosure, the hubs differ in size and shape. The Wink Hub 2 has a tall, rectangular shape (7.25 inches tall) while the SmartThings comes in a small square shape ( 5 x 5 inches) with round edges.
