The energy stored on a capacitor can be expressed in terms of the work done by the battery. Voltage represents energy per unit charge, so the work to move a charge element dq from the negative plate to the positive plate is equal to $V dq$, where V is the voltage on the capacitor. 3.1 Battery energy storage. The battery energy storage is considered as the oldest and most mature storage system which stores electrical energy in the form of chemical energy [47, 48]. A BES consists of number of individual cells connected in series and parallel [49]. Each cell has cathode and anode with an electrolyte [50].

The energy stored in a battery is calculated by multiplying the voltage of the battery by the capacity of the battery in ampere-hours. For example, a battery with a capacity of 1000 mAh and a voltage of 3.7 volts would have an energy storage capacity of 3.7 watt-hours (Wh).. It is important to note that battery capacity is not the same as the power output of a ...

Chemical energy is taken from the battery as electrical energy and used to accelerate the rotating mass. Thus; kinetic (mechanical) energy is stored in the flywheel. Then, by using the motor as a generator the kinetic energy in the flywheel can be converted back into electrical energy, and re-stored in the battery as chemical energy.
