

# Can I put clothes in the locker under the bed

How do you store clothes under a bed?

Using the empty space beneath your bed for extra clothes storage is a go-to strategy. You can buy storage containers or use what you already have for a budget-friendly solution. Should you store clothing under a bed?

Storing clothing, bedding or out-of-season items under a bed means that they are close by and convenient should you need to access them in a hurry - unlike items stored in an attic - plus they are out of sight, which allows your more decor-friendly bedroom ideas to shine.

How do you store a dresser under a bed?

If your bedroom is small, swap out your dresser for under-the-bed storage. You can buy plastic bins or baskets that are low enough to fit under your bed. Look for products that come on casters to make it easier to roll out from under the bed. Or, add DIY casters for wheel-y easy under-the-bed storage.

How do you store a room under a bed?

It's a good idea to purchase -- or repurpose or build -- storage items that fit properly under the bed, rather than simply sliding bins or boxes beneath. If the room is prone to dust, consider lidded containers; if you want frequent access to your items, choose storage solutions with wheels or add your own casters. Ready to get started?

How do I choose a good underbed storage bed?

To gain maximum underbed storage space, a bed that incorporates built-in storage is a good choice as it will use the entire underbed area, unlike roll-out drawers that are unlikely to be an exact fit - so if you are browsing new bed ideas, think purpose-designed storage beds.

Should you put storage under a bed?

“In smaller homes or homes without adequate storage, using the space under the bed provides additional options,” says Lisa Mark, a certified professional organizer at The Time Butler in Los Altos, Calif. “Under-bed space keeps items contained and out of sight and serves as a physical boundary to curtail the number of items coming into the space.
