How to install solar panels?

Make space for the solar panel accessories (solar inverter, cables and solar batteries, if desired), for instance in a plant room 4. Plan a day for installation 5. Erect the scaffolding (this can be done by your supplier or by a company you organise) 6. The solar panel mounts will be installed 7. The professionals will install the solar panels 8.

Are DIY solar panels legal in the UK?

Yes. UK law is pretty relaxed about DIY solar panels, and in most cases you don't even need planning permission to install a full-sized array of solar panels by yourself. But going DIY may mean you miss out on government schemes, product warranties and utility company support, because you won't have the necessary paperwork or certification.

Do I need planning permission to install solar panels on my roof?

When considering the installation of solar panels on your roof, it's critical to understand if you need permission. In the UK, solar panel installations often fall under "Permitted Development," meaning you typically won't need planning permission.

Can you build your own solar panels?

To get straight to the point, yes, you can build your own solar panels, or at least partially, depending on the craftsmanship of each person. The process DIY includes sizing the solar panel system, choosing which components suits your needs, mounting and installing the solar panels, the solar inverter and safety disconnects.
