

## Can a backup power supply get a virus

But power failures can also cause head crashes in hard drives, which can damage a disk and the data on it. To guard against power failures, I do recommend that you get an uninterruptible power supply (UPS) to provide a backup power source for your computer. A UPS, at its core, is a battery backup power supply.

The best I can suggest is to back up to external media. Wait as many days as you can. Get an up-to-date virus scanner, or preferably several, and scan the media. There's more chance if you leave it that at least one scanner will have been updated to spot the virus. -
