

Can shared lockers be placed on the roadside

Can a neighbour Park on a shared driveway?

Legally, no. Parking on a shared driveway is technically classed as obstructing a highway, which is against the law. Sometimes, neighbours will make arrangements between themselves around parking on a shared driveway. However, neither party has a legal right to park on a shared driveway. Often, neighbours will share a driveway harmoniously.

What are my rights with a shared driveway?

Your rights with a shared driveway will depend on who owns the driveway and what the conditions are set out in the title deeds. If the driveway is owned jointly by all parties that have use of it, then everyone has an equal right to use the driveway. This means that they can't block access to the driveway or stop anyone from using it.

What happens if a neighbour blocks a shared driveway?

So if a neighbour blocks a shared driveway (by parking on it, for example), they are breaking the law and they could be fined for it. Therefore, legally owners of a shared driveway have a responsibility to be considerate and not block the driveway. Who owns a shared driveway?

You can also ask your neighbours if they use the same driveway. If they do, then it's most likely a shared driveway. A shared driveway is usually owned jointly by all parties that have use of the driveway. However, this isn't always the case.
