Can I put more than one parcel in a locker box?

You can put only one parcel in a Locker box. If you want to send more than one parcel, book a separate order for each one. Scan each parcel separately and put each one in its own Locker box. Please ensure your parcel has a label attached before you drop it off at a Locker.

How do I send a parcel to a locker?

We'll also send you a barcode - simply scan or enter the barcode number at the Locker to open the door to your parcel. Selected retailers also allow you to divert your parcel to a Locker while it's out for delivery. You can ask your courier to deliver to Locker by selecting the option when tracking your parcel.

How do I use a locker?

It's easy to use a Locker. At the terminal, scan the barcode on your shipping label or manually enter the 16-digit number. A door will automatically open. Place your parcel in the compartment, close the door and we'll do the rest! Drop off by 12pm for same-day collection. And a door will automatically open.

Can I divert my parcel to a locker?

Selected retailers also allow you to divert your parcel to a Locker while it's out for delivery. You can ask your courier to deliver to Locker by selecting the option when tracking your parcel. Please note that parcels that require proof of delivery can't be diverted, and some retailers don't allow parcel diversions.
