Any package bearing a lithium battery shipping label should also be marked as dangerous goods and have the necessary documentation; It may be necessary to use specialized packaging to ensure the safety; Lithium Metal Batteries These are batteries that use lithium as an anode. They have a long life and can produce anywhere between 1.5V-3.7V.

Shipments of electronic items containing lithium cells and batteries are prohibited when sent using the International Courier product. You cannot send lithium batteries to Bhutan, Germany, Italy, Laos, Macao or Thailand.

You can only send a maximum of 2 lithium batteries or 4 lithium cells, regardless of whether they are lithium metal or lithium-ion batteries. What products we cannot ship with lithium batteries Generally, we are unable to ship E-bikes containing lithium ion batteries as they are over 100 wh in size, we are not accredited to ship this size of ...

Lithium batteries are dangerous goods, and all of the regulatory requirements must be complied with, as set out in the Lithium Battery Shipping Regulations. In the United States, failure to comply with these regulations can result in a civil penalty of up to \$27,000 per offence (LBSR 1.3).

Officially, yes: Lithium-ion batteries are governed under the United Nations regulations UN3480 and UN3481 as Class 9 "miscellaneous dangerous goods." Two dangers stand out: First, improperly packaged lithium-ion batteries can lead to short circuits if they come into contact with each other or with other conductive surfaces. Second, thermal runaway can occur if improperly ...

You may only mail lithium batteries: Meeting the conditions outlined in Schedule 2, Special Provision 34 of the Transportation of Dangerous Goods Regulations. Subject to the restrictions set out in the table below ; Please note: You aren't allowed to ship lithium batteries to any destination outside of Canada and the U.S.

Only with appropriate packaging and handling can you safely send lithium batteries and similar hazardous goods across the country or worldwide. How Do Lithium Batteries Work? However, individual batteries are prohibited from USPS international shipping.
