



# China-Myanmar border solar power generation project

What is Myanmar-China-Myanmar interconnection project?

In Jan 2018, MOEE proposed 500 kV Myanmar-China power interconnection project and Bangladesh-China-Myanmar interconnection project. The former starts from Yunnan (China) to Phayargyi (Myanmar) with a total capacity of 1000 MW and a distance of 980 km in China and 899 km in Myanmar, respectively.

Why is China a major power supplier in Myanmar?

With Myanmar facing a massive power shortfall amid growing domestic demand, China has become its major electricity supplier, including through cross-border power interconnection projects, due to its lower prices, among other factors.

What is the impact of China and Myanmar's energy cooperation?

In 2016, Myanmar's investment of energy sector in China reaches US\$115.98 million while China's investment of energy sector in Myanmar reaches US\$20.5 billion [63]. The cooperation has a far-reaching impact on high-efficient energy utilization and is of great economic and political significance.

Who owns Myanmar's Indian Ocean Project?

The project was developed by Kyauk Phyu Electric Power Co. Ltd., a joint venture between Chinese state-owned firm Power China Resources and Myanmar's Supreme Group. China is a major investor in Myanmar, and has placed importance on projects that will give it access to the Indian Ocean.

Is China accelerating Myanmar-China cross-border power interconnection projects?

According to the Chinese Embassy in Myanmar's Facebook page, the ambassador said during the opening ceremony that Myanmar-China cross-border power interconnection projects are accelerating, and China is now "calmly discussing and implementing the important projects like [the] Kyaukphyu SEZ and China-Myanmar interlink Ruili-Kyaukphyu railway."

What is the current power system in Myanmar?

Overview of Myanmar existing power system and projected system plan. Myanmar central power grid extends around Yangon-Mandalay load center and covers most of central provinces.
