How do I get a solar system in DC?

Solar for All Community Solar: DOEE is working with the DC Sustainable Energy Utility (DCSEU) on the Solar for All program. Single-family DC residents can apply to get solar systems installed directly on their roofs by working with the DCSEU. Can you get paid for solar power in DC?

D.C. has set a renewable portfolio standard goal to produce 5% percent of its electricity from solar resources in 2032, and you can get paid to help. Under this program, you are granted one D.C. SREC for each megawatt-hour (MWh) of clean electricity your panels produce, which you can then sell in the SREC market.

Washington D.C. solar incentives like tax credits and rebates allow you to save money when you go solar - learn which incentives are available.

What is solar for all?

The Renewable Portfolio Standard Expansion Amendment Act of 2016 established the District's Solar for All Program (Solar for All). The Act intends to increase the amount of solar generated within the District, providing the benefits of locally-generated solar energy to low- to moderate- income households, small businesses, nonprofits, and seniors.

How do I check if a solar developer / contractor is a DOEE solar for all?

Community Solar Community solar provides the benefits of solar to residents who can't install systems on their home, including renters and homeowners whose rooftops are shaded or need repairs.

How many SRECs do solar panels generate a year?

As a solar panel system owner, you generate one SREC for every megawatt-hour (MWh) of electricity your solar energy system produces. So, the average D.C. homeowner buying an eight-kilowatt (kW) system typically generates about 10 MWh of solar electricity per year, equal to 10 SRECs.
