How long does a Nintendo Switch battery last?

This page contains information on the batteries or battery preservation options available for the Nintendo Switch. While the Switch's battery does last a few hours, many users are searching for answers on how to replace the system's built-in battery -- either to bring along a spare for long trips, or to replace a faulty and short-lived battery.

Can you put a Nintendo Switch down without charging?

It'll be tempting to let the Nintendo Switch's battery run down to 10% or even 0% before charging, especially when using it in handheld mode on the couch or in bed. However, you should plug it in as soon as possible after the battery level drops. This is not good for the battery.

Why does a switch have a lithium ion battery?

The Nintendo Switch (and its controllers) uses a Lithium Ion battery (LIB). Think of the LIB as a battery with a stored charge, represented by a spring that wants to push up.

Does Nintendo charge for a battery replacement?

If your Switch is still under warranty and exhibiting poor battery life, contacting Nintendo about a replacement is the best way to get a resolution without voiding your warranty. There may be a charge for the battery replacement, depending on how old your Switch is, but Nintendo doesn't disclose the exact fee on their website.

Does the Nintendo Switch overcharge its battery?

Nintendo Switch batteries do not get overcharged. The Switch is designed for long play sessions while docked, in TV Mode, with the battery at 100%. Nintendo offers a service to help maintain the battery, but keeping it happy is essential for the Switch to run great for years to come.

Does a Nintendo Switch use Bluetooth?

Your Switch uses Bluetooth, wireless, and other features unless manually turned off. When you're playing on the go, you can disable some of these features (or just switch the system to Airplane Mode) to get the most life out of your battery. Bluetooth is needed to play with the Joy-Con detached, but you're fine without it in handheld mode.

According to Nintendo, the battery life of the Nintendo Switch can range from 2.5 to 9 hours, depending on the model and the software application and functions being used. For the original model (HAC-001), the battery life ranges from 2.5 to 6.5 hours. For the revised model (HAC-001(-01)), the battery life is approximately 4.5 to 9 hours.

Important: As with most lithium-ion batteries, the console battery life will gradually decrease over time. After about 800 charge cycles, the console battery life will decrease to about 80% compared to the battery on a new console. This is normal and does not represent an issue with the console or with the battery.

Yes. However, in the case of the Switch, the dock will generally keep the battery up at 100%. It would be great if Nintendo offered a "battery lifespan" option that kept the Switch battery at 80% except when a full charge is needed, but we shouldn't expect that.
