Does USPS accept lithium batteries?

The USPS has revised its hazardous materials shipping regulations, restrictions and guidance--Publication 52, better known simply as Pub 52--to further restrict how the service accepts and transports lithium battery devices. (Standalone batteries are not subject to these new rules.) There are two important new restrictions:

Did the postal service change the shipping standards for lithium batteries?

The Postal Service announced these revisions via a Federal Register notice titled "Revision to Mailing Standards for Lithium Batteries," which was published on July 26, 2017 (82 FR 34712-34715).

Can a lithium battery be attached to a mailpiece?

Except for mailpieces containing button cell batteries properly installed in the equipment they are intended to operate, mailpieces containing mailable lithium metal or lithium-ion batteries must be rigid, sealed, and of adequate size, so the lithium battery mark can be affixed to the address side without the mark being folded.

Do I need a Dot label to ship lithium batteries?

NO device in box (via Surface Only) Besides the above DOT labels, text markings are required for shipping individual batteries without the equipment. For example, the below box used text-markings besides DOT and shipping labels. How to Ship Lithium Batteries Internationally with USPS?

How do you mark a mailpiece with a lithium battery?

Except for mailpieces containing button cell batteries properly installed in the equipment they are intended to operate, mailpieces containing lithium metal batteries must be rigid, sealed, and of adequate size, so the mark can be affixed to the address side without the mark being folded.

Do I need DOT approved lithium battery markings?

n Require DOT-approved lithium battery markings on all mailpieces containing lithium cells or batteries contained in equipment when there are more than two mailpieces in a single consignment in domestic mail. n Limit a single consignment to two mailpieces containing lithium batteries for international and APO/FPO/DPO mail.

However, for these shipment types, USPS will allow the optional use of the applicable lithium battery handling label in either domestic air or surface transport. Note: If you choose to use the lithium battery handling label the dimensions and specifications must be as specified in 49 CFR 173.185.

When shipping lithium batteries, businesses must comply with U.S. Department of Transportation (DOT) standards and Pipeline and Hazardous Materials Safety Administration (PHMSA) standards for preparing shipments ...

Lithium battery consignment means one or more mailpieces containing lithium batteries, entered into USPS networks by one mailer or mail service provider within a single mailing or retail transaction, ... The address side of the outer packaging must bear the magnetized material warning label shown in Exhibit 349.242 b and a shipping paper is ...

Lithium battery mark labels are not required for packages that contain no more than four cells or two batteries contained in devices. Transport of Dangerous Goods by Post in accordance with Section 2.4 of the IATA Regulations. Section 2.4.1: The Universal Postal Union Convention forbids the carriage of Dangerous Goods in mail except as permitted ...

We aren't a tiny operation but aren't large either. In the month of November we have had over 100 packages returned and stamped "rejected contains lithium battery". Every package is the same, they get rejected in Chicago which is the last stop before leaving internationally. Does anyone have any thoughts or can provide any guidance.

Persons wishing to ship lithium batteries and electronic devices containing lithium batteries by mail should be aware that certain requirements must be met to ensure safety during transport. Ground transportation requirement: USPS only permits lithium battery shipments via ground transportation due to safety concerns related to overheating and fire hazards during air transport. Packaging and labeling guidelines: When shipping lithium batteries via USPS, proper packaging and labeling are essential.

A lithium battery label or sticker is a mandatory requirement for all lithium batteries being transported. This label or sticker must clearly indicate that the package contains lithium batteries. It should be placed on a visible and accessible location on the outer packaging. 2. Lithium Battery Transport Warning Label

Orders containing a standalone lithium battery cannot be sent via 2 Day or Overnight shipping. Orders containing a standalone lithium battery cannot be shipped to Hawaii, Alaska, U.S. Territories, or FPO/APO/DPO addresses because Standard (Ground) service is not available to these locations. Items must be packaged in accordance with Packing Instructions 967 (Lithium Ion or Rechargeable) or 970 (Lithium Metal or Non-rechargeable). Both Packing Instructions prohibit the use of the "Lithium Battery Handling" label or the "Class 9 Miscellaneous Dangerous Goods" label on the outside of the package for international mailing.

The Common Types of Lithium Battery Labels. Lithium battery shipping labels UN3080, UN3081, UN3490, and UN3491 are used to identify and properly handle packages containing lithium batteries during transport. Here's an explanation of each label and their main differences: 1. UN3480: Lithium-Ion batteries

You can get this label from a postal store or online. The label should have the words "Lithium Battery" and "UN 3481" on it, along with a picture of a battery with a flame on it. You have to place this label on the top of the box, next to the shipping label. You also have to place this label on the side of the box, next to the barcode ...

A lithium battery label for shipping is a label that contains a battery symbol and a red border of 5mm placed on the packaging. The full label measures a minimum of 4" x 4" (100mm x 100mm) and contains the following graphic and text information, such as the UN number and contact details.

So, I just got back from the post office, to ship 2 cell phones and a package with some flashlights, and the post office employee wrote a code on the box for the flashlights (since they had batteries that were not inside the flashlights). I believe that the code was UN3481, which someone specifically mentioned in a comment in this thread.

If you do not have a pouch, affix the label to your package using clear plastic shipping tape over the entire

label. Do not cover any seams or closures on the package. Affix the lithium battery mark to the top or one of the sides of the box. The lithium battery mark cannot be affixed to the bottom of the box. The lithium battery mark must be ...

The maximum number of lithium batteries allowed in each parcel is the minimum number required to power the device plus two spares; For lithium ion/polymer batteries the Watt-hour rating must not exceed 20Wh per cell or 100Wh per battery; For lithium metal/alloy batteries the lithium content must not be more than 1g per cell or 2g per battery

The introduction of the telephone number requirement for lithium battery labels initially left many shippers and carriers puzzled. There was uncertainty regarding its similarity to the 24-hour telephone number requirement in many countries, however, neither the UN nor national regulations explicitly stated that this number needed to be available around the clock.

Effective August 17, 2017, the Postal Service(TM) is revising Publication 52, Hazardous, Restricted, and Perishable Mail, in various sections to provide new mailing standards for mailpieces containing lithium batteries. For domestic mailings only, small consumer-type primary lithium cells or batteries (lithium metal or lithium alloy) like those used to power cameras and flashlights are mailable domestically under certain conditions.

USPS Standards for Domestic Shipments Containing Lithium Batteries. Each cell cannot contain more than 1 gram of lithium; Each battery cannot contain more than 2 grams of lithium; All packages must contain a complete return address; For non-installed batteries, your package must have a DOT-approved lithium battery mark (UN3090)

Types of Battery Warning Labels. The types of battery warning labels cater to different kinds of batteries and transportation scenarios. The most common types include: Lithium battery labels: For lithium-ion and lithium-metal batteries, indicating specific hazards and handling precautions. Cargo aircraft only labels: For batteries restricted to ...

As most lithium battery shippers are aware, it is a general requirement for small (excepted) lithium ion batteries with a power rating of not more than 100 Wh, and lithium metal batteries of not more than 2 grams lithium content, to only require the lithium battery handling mark (label) to be displayed on packages.
