You can store breast milk in a sterilised container or in special breast milk storage bags: Breast milk that's been cooled in the fridge can be carried in a cool bag with ice packs for up to 24 hours. Storing breast milk in small quantities will help avoid waste. If you're freezing it, make sure you label and date it first.

Can breastmilk be stored in ice packs?

Protect your milk from direct contact with the ice packs or it may freeze - try wrapping the ice packs in kitchen towel. The bag can also be used to carry milk. The lower the storage temperature, the longer expressed breastmilk can be stored.

How long can you keep frozen breast milk?

However, using the frozen milk within six months is optimal. Keep in mind that research suggests that the longer you store breast milk -- whether in the refrigerator or in the freezer -- the greater the loss of vitamin C in the milk. It's also important to note that your breast milk changes to meet your baby's needs.

Can breast milk be stored in the refrigerator or freezer?

Do not store breast milk in the door of the refrigerator or freezer. Storing it further inside will help protect the breast milk from temperature changes when the door opens and closes. If you don't think you will use freshly expressed breast milk within 4 days, freeze it right away. This will help to protect the quality of the breast milk.

In the freezer: Breast milk can be stored in the freezer (at 0°F/-18°C or lower) for up to 6 months. In a cool bag with ice packs: Chilled breast milk will keep for 24 hours in a cool ...
