Are solar panels worth it?

Solar panels can generate major savings if you're trying to reduce your electricity costs, carbon emissions or both. The primary factor in determining whether or not solar panels are worthwhile for you is the cost you're currently paying for electricity. The higher your electricity costs, the more a solar panel system will save you in the long run.

How much do solar panels cost in 2022?

We analyzed thousands of systems sold on solar.com in 2022 to find the average cost of solar panels for homes based on their square footage of living space and number of bedrooms. On average, solar panels cost \$8.77 per square foot of living space, after factoring in the 30% tax credit.

Are solar panels cheaper than coal?

The cost of solar panels has dropped by about 90% over the last decade, such that at the utility scale, in many locations in the U.S., solar energy is the least costly alternative for new electrical power generation. It now costs less to build a new solar power plant than to continue to operate a coal plant.

How much does solar cost per kWh?
