



How to bind WeChat and Alipay to the power grid

How do I pay electricity using Alipay & WeChat wallet?

To pay electricity, link your utilities account to the payment platform, then specify the amount of money you want to recharge. To complete the transaction, enter your six-digit Alipay or WeChat Wallet payment PIN.

Can I use WeChat Pay & Alipay with my credit card?

Instead, you will primarily be using WeChat Pay and Alipay as a means for you to make payments using your credit card. Do note that both Alipay and WeChat Pay waives the international credit card transaction fees of 3% for only transactions under RMB 200. For any amount greater than that, the 3% surcharge will be added to your payment.

How to use Alipay & WeChat mobile app in China?

Previously, in order to activate the payment function on Alipay or WeChat's mobile app, users would first need to have either a China bank account or a Chinese bank-issued credit card. And to have either of these, users need to be a Chinese citizen or a resident with a valid residential address in China.

Can I use WeChat Pay without a China bank account?

WeChat Pay is a payment gateway where users pay using credit cards linked to their mobile phones, similar to Apple Pay and Google Pay. But this also means that WeChat Pay users without a linked China bank account will not be able to receive funds into their WeChat Pay account.

Do Alipay and WeChat Pay have in-app currency exchange rates?

Both Alipay and WeChat Pay do not have in-app currency exchange rates. Instead, the exchange rate is determined by the issuer of the linked credit cards. Although both Alipay and WeChat Pay support mobile payments, they are inherently different apps. Alipay is an online payment platform, similar to PayPal.
