Do you need planning permission to install solar panels?

Current rules that require businesses to apply for planning permission if solar panels will generate more than one megawatt of electricity will also be scrapped, meaning organisations will be able to install more solar panels on rooftops without the delay and cost of applying for planning permission.

Do I need planning permission to install solar panels on a flat roof?

Before installing solar panels on a flat roof located on Article 2 (3) land, you must apply to your local planning authority (LPA) for prior approval to assess their impact on the appearance of the site. If the LPA deems the impact detrimental, then planning permission is required.

Do you need planning permission for solar panels on flats & apartments?

Gaining planning permission for solar panels on flats and apartments is possible, and whether you'll require permission is based on the same factors as for houses. However, planning permission for flats and apartments comes with a bit more administrative red tape.

Can solar panels be installed without a planning system?

Changes to permitted development rights rules will mean more homeowners and businesses will be able to install solar panels on their roofs without going through the planning system. Currently those who have to go through the planning system are having to wait over eight weeks and face extra costs.

Can a tenant install a solar panel?

If you're a tenant, you'll need to request permission for the solar panel installation from your landlord and make a convincing case regarding the domestic solar array's environmental, financial and reputational benefits.

Can solar panels be installed on a flat roof?

Permitted development rights for solar panels have been extended with planning permission no longer being required for installation on homes with flat roofs. The changes will aim to empower more property owners to effortlessly install solar panels on their roofs, bypassing the often time-consuming planning system.
