Can lithium ion batteries be recycled?

Lithium-ion batteries and devices containing these batteries should NOT go in household garbage or recycling bins. Lithium-ion batteries SHOULD be taken to separate recycling or household hazardous waste collection points. To prevent fires, tape battery terminals and/or place lithium-ion batteries in separate plastic bags.

Where can I recycle button batteries?

Button cell contain silver and mercury. They must be recycled. You can take them to Call2Recycle drop-off sites, like those at The Home Depot. Watch repair shops may also take these batteries for recycling. Keep all batteries out of the reach of children, but especially button batteries.

How do you dispose of lithium ion batteries?

Never dump used batteries into your regular waste. Don't crush or pierce the batteries as this can lead to leakage or short-circuiting. Don't store large quantities of li-ion batteries close together without capping or taping off exposed connectors. Never throw li-ion batteries in the regular blue recycling bin.

The responsible recycling of the batteries that power these products and others can divert millions of pounds of potentially harmful metals from landfills and help preserve valuable natural resources. Feb. 18 is National Battery Day, and a great time to raise awareness around just how easy it is to recycle batteries at the end of their useful life.

It is important to cover the terminals, as Lithium batteries spark and cause fires. If your battery becomes damaged, contact your manufacturer and ask how to handle it. Check for the word "Lithium" in your battery packaging to ensure it is lithium. Make sure it has no charge left to avoid causing fires when you give it to a recycler.

If a lithium-ion battery becomes damaged, contact the battery or device manufacturer for specific handling information. EPA recommendation: Look for labels identifying battery chemistry. Do not put rechargeable batteries in the trash or municipal recycling bins. Find a recycling location near you: Ni-Cd; Li-ion; Ni-MH; Ni-Zn; Pb; Lithium-Ion ...

Depends on the type of battery. Rechargeable batteries (those found in your Kobalt cordless drill, for example) can be recycled at certain retailers, including Lowe's. Not Accepted Alkaline batteries (AA, AAA, C, D) and any other battery types not mentioned here. Most of the heavy metal has been removed from alkaline batteries, so it is ok to dispose of them in your regular household garbage.

The "Battery Act" (The Mercury-Containing and Rechargeable Battery Management Act of 1996) was set out to ensure that batteries such as li-ion batteries can be recycled for reuse, instead of being released into the environment. DROP OFF: The final step of safe battery recycling It's important not to store used batteries in your home for too long, where they can become corroded. Whether you use a lot of batteries or just a few, we recommend dropping them off at least every three months to prevent corrosion and battery leakage.

Yes, lithium batteries can be recycled under the definition of solid waste recycling exclusion at 40 CFR 261.4(a)(24) and/or 40 CFR 261.4(a)(25) (for recycling occurring domestically and after export, respectively) as long as (1) both the state that the batteries are generated in and the state in which the recycling takes place have adopted ...
