How many new solar farms have been approved?

Threenew solar farms have been approved. Pic: PA The government has approved three new solar farms,that could power more than 400,000 homes,according to estimates. Energy Secretary Ed Miliband has approved the plans for projects at Mallard Pass,Rutland and Lincolnshire,Sunnica in Suffolk and Cambridgeshire,and Gate Burton in Lincolnshire.

The generating capacity would be up to 500MWand the 380-hectare (939-acre) farm would also have battery storage. Mr Shapps said the development would "help ensure we fully harness the power of the sun and boost our energy security";

Can a solar farm power 115,000 homes a year?

A solar farm and battery project capable of powering 115,000 homes annuallyby delivering up to 500 megawatts (MW) of electricity is being proposed by an energy developer. Island Green Power said the project,known as East Pye Solar,is planned for land in Long Stratton,Norfolk,and will be able to provide energy over the next 60 years.

Will a new solar farm boost UK energy security?

Energy Security Secretary Grant Shapps said: "The UK already has enough solar power installed to power four million homes,and this new development of Longfield,the UK's largest capacity consented solar farm,will help ensure we fully harness the power of the sun and boost our energy security."
