Are We moving into the age of electricity?

"In energy history,we've witnessed the age of coal and the age of oil," said Fatih Birol,the executive director of the International Energy Agency. "We're now moving at speed into the age of electricity,which will define the global energy system going forward." Electricity demand has historically gone up as societies grow more affluent.

Does New York have a coal-fired power plant?

Coal, which accounted for 16% of the state's electricity net generation two decades ago, no longer fuels any of New York's in-state net generation. 41 The state's last coal-fired power plant closed in 2020. 42 In 2022, New York was one of the six states that did not have any utility-scale coal-fired electricity generation. 43

Does New York have a gas generator?

New York has many smaller landfill gas-fueled generators across the state,accounting for one-fourth of the state's biomass-generating capacity.

Will Biden spend \$73 billion on new power lines?
