On the other hand, when the user needs electrical power from which the PV solar panels generate, they can take energy from the utility company.. When the PV system generates more power than the homeowner requires, the customer is often able to sell excess electricity to the grid, and when the homeowner's electricity needs exceeds the capacity of the system, the home draws energy from the grid as usual. The primary component in grid-connected PV systems is the inverter, or power conditioning unit (PCU). The PCU converts the DC power produced by the PV array into AC power consistent with the voltage and power quality requirements of the utility grid, and automatically stops supplying power to the grid when the utility grid is not energized. ...

In 2000 grid-connected PV had overtaken stand-alone systems in global market share, and in 2016 more than 98% of solar cell production was being deployed in grid-connected systems. An on-grid or grid-tied solar system is a system that works along with the grid.

Grid connected photovoltaic systems (GCPVS) are the application of photovoltaic (PV) solar energy that have shown the most growth in the world. Since 1997, the amount of GCPVS power installed annually is greater than that all other terrestrial applications of PV technology combined .

PV systems are most commonly in the grid-connected configuration because it is easier to design and typically less expensive compared to off-grid PV systems, which rely on batteries. Grid-connected PV systems allow homeowners to consume less power from the grid and supply unused or excess power back to the utility grid (see Figure 2 ).

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A grid-tied solar system has a special inverter that can receive power from the grid or send grid-quality AC power to the utility grid when there is an excess of energy from the solar system. Figure. Grid-Connected Solar PV System Block Diagram In addition, the utility company can produce power from solar farms and send power to the grid directly.

PV Modules and Balance of System (BOS) PV modules typically comprise a rectangular grid of 60 to 72 cells, laminated between a transparent front surface and a structural back surface. They usually have metal frames and weigh 34 to 62 lbs. 12; A PV array is a group of modules, connected electrically and fastened to a rigid structure. 13

A system connected to the utility grid is known as a grid-connected energy system or a grid-connected PV system. Through this grid-tied connection, the system can capture solar energy, transform it into electrical power, and supply it to the homes where various electronic devices can use it.
