What is WeChat Pay?

Also known as Weixin Pay, WeChat Pay is a mobile payment system and digital wallet service that enables WeChat users to make payments directly through the app. WeChat Pay supports several payment flows, including QR code, in-app, Mini Program, and Official Account payments.

What is WeChat Pay (Weixin pay)?

WeChat Pay, officially referred to as Weixin Pay (Chinese: 微信支付; pinyin: Weixīn Zhīfēi) in China, is a mobile payment and digital wallet service by WeChat based in China that allows users to make mobile payments and online transactions. As of March 2016, WeChat Pay had over 300 million users.

How to use WeChat Pay in China?

After linking the card to WeChat Pay, you will be asked to create a payment password. This password will be used for transaction payment. Now, start using WeChat Pay in China to make transactions. 4. Real Name Authentication In order to comply with relevant laws and regulations, WeChat Pay now requires real name authentication for all users.

How do I pay a bill on WeChat?

To pay in stores, open WeChat, go to "Wallet," tap on "QR Code for Payment," and let the cashier scan your QR code. You can also scan the store's QR code and enter the amount you need to pay. You can pay for utilities and services directly through WeChat by navigating to the "Bills" section of the Wallet menu.

Does WeChat Pay support recurring payments?

Merchants can currently use WeChat Pay to support 26 settlement currencies, including US dollars, Euros, and British pounds. WeChat Pay merchants are expected to display the WeChat Pay logo for their customers to see. Although WeChat Pay supports several different payment flows, it doesn't currently process customer recurring payments.

How does WeChat work?

Merchants scan the code to take the payment. Users open WeChat to scan the code, confirm the amount, and make the payment after passing the security checks. Users pay for goods or services in Mini Programs created inside WeChat. Users can pay for goods and services inside the merchant's Official Account.
