By some counts, Americans buy nearly 180 tons of batteries each year - a nationwide recycling strategy is wise and responsible. Fortunately, alkaline batteries haven't contained harmful materials for over 25 years, and the U.S. passed a law in 1996 phasing out the use of mercury in batteries, so progress has been made.

Recycle your old batteries by first determining what type of battery you have, then using a service like Call2Recycle, Earth911, or GreenerGadgets, to find a local recycling drop-off, pick-up, or mail-in program.
