Why do aquariums need a battery backup system?

Having an aquarium controller like the Neptune Apex hooked up to a battery backup system can be really handy to automatically drop the flow rate and thus the power consumption of the pumps it controls when it senses a power outage.

How many powerheads does an aquarium battery backup system run?

Aquarium battery backup systems typically run one or two powerheads. Systems with larger capacity can run DC-powered return pumps, or heaters and lights if designed large enough. The main benefit to battery systems is to automatically keep a pump or two running during outages of a few hours.

How do I Keep my aquarium tank safe from power outages?

Among the several threats that homeowners and companies face during these times are prolonged power outages. Make sure to keep your aquarium tank safe from power outages by installing one of the following five aquarium battery back-ups. Do you need a battery backup system for corals?

The Controllable DC pumps from Ecotech and Reef Octopus are your best option if you wish to easily add them to your battery backup system. These are not required to be ran unless you start getting into days without power. By the time you need to run lights for your corals, you will probably have been on a generator-powered system for a while!

How long does an aquarium battery backup system last?

Aquarium battery backup systems on average will run between 8-48 hours depending on the system installed and the equipment it powers. Powering just a single pump will run twice as long as running two pumps. Run Time = Battery Capacity/Amps drawn by the equipment.

What is the best UPS battery backup system?

The last in our list of reviews is the AmazonBasics Standby UPS Battery Backup by AmazonBasics. This system is mainly for small electronic devices. It works excellently for small aquarium tanks with low-rated power consumption. It features a UPS power input and battery back up of 600VA/ 360 W respectively.

Heaters are one of your strongest drawing electrical devices on your tank. I have a 200w plugged in to my backup just in case. Now granted my backup will only run for about 3 hours in the event of power loss. That is one powerhead, heater, and return pump.

To find the amp hour of run time. I sold a guy a 800 watt inverter and 2 6volt golf cart batteries. He is able to run a full 125 gal reef tank for 10 hours.

I estimate the power station requiring at least 2000 watts output capability. Just to be clear, I already own a backup battery for DC pump flow. The thought is, I want to purchase a portable power station anyway, so why not have one that is big enough, with built in UPS, so it can power my tank. The capacity is easy to research.
