Renewable energy, (RE) law also relates to the land use, siting, and finance issues encountered by developers of renewable energy projects.

Electricity is considered a secondary energy source because it is generated (produced) from primary energy sources.

The 2005 Energy Law established the guidelines for energy policy and required that the proportion of renewable energy in the energy consumption structure reach 10% in 2010. Moreover, it delineated a wind energy development zone, where the pricing mechanism was set by the government [23] .

For example, law can determine that renewable energy projects are eligible for subsidization, whereas fossil fuel projects are not, therefore allocating economic advantages to low-carbon energy activities and steering investment toward low-carbon goals (Hancher, de Hauteclocque and Salerno, 2018).
