

Do solar panels need a roof racking system?

Designers must design roofing systems for the structural impact of existing, new and future solar panel installations. How do roof mounted PV solar panels work?

The mechanically fastened system penetrates through the roofing membrane and can be used in pitched roofs and flat roofs.

What is a roof mounted photovoltaic system guidance?

The guidance refers only to the mechanical installation of roof mounted integrated and stand-off photovoltaic systems; it provides best practice guidance on installation requirements and does not constitute fixing instructions.

What is a solar racking?

The solar rack is the hardware under the solar module that secures the panel to a surface (roof, ground, pole) in the panel installation. If you don't get this right, then forget it—you are just buying yourself years of trouble. In this learning article, we will focus on how to select the proper solar racking.

Can a racking system be used to ground a PV module?

This racking system may be used to ground and/or mount a PV module complying with UL 1703 only when the specific module has been evaluated for grounding and/or mounting in compliance with the included instructions. The system is a non-separately derived system.
