How do I install a solar photovoltaic system?

Installing solar photovoltaic systems requires specialized skills and knowledge. Installation should only be performed by qualified personnel. Before installing a solar photovoltaic system, installers should familiarize themselves with its mechanical and electrical requirements.

How to install solar panels?

Make space for the solar panel accessories (solar inverter, cables and solar batteries, if desired), for instance in a plant room 4. Plan a day for installation 5. Erect the scaffolding (this can be done by your supplier or by a company you organise) 6. The solar panel mounts will be installed 7. The professionals will install the solar panels 8.

How do you install solar panels on a roof?

Start with a solid foundation, which is essential to add solar panels to a roof or a ground platform. For roof installation, lag bolts are attached to the rafters, and a piece of flashing is used on top of the shingles to prevent leaks. The flashing slides under the shingle wherever a lag bolt installation occurs.

Which direction should solar panels be installed?

“Solar PV (photovoltaic) panels generate electricity from sunlight and will normally be installed on the roof of the building facing in the most south direction. The panels should also face as much south as possible. If you faced east, or west, then expect a yield of around 20% less generation annually” explains David Hilton.

Can Trina Solar modules be installed in landscape or portrait orientation?
