Does WeChat have content surveillance?

Content surveillance between users of accounts registered outside of China is functionally undetectable. None of WeChat's public-facing policy documents, personal data access requests processes, or privacy officers communicated that the company is conducting this surveillance.

Are government WeChat Official accounts growing?

The growth of Chinese government WeChat official accounts, including the TMB account (the subject of this study), is still in its preliminary phase. The TMB account, which was designed to be a general platform for all traffic-related services, has turned out to be a lookup tool.

Does WeChat monitor censorship?

To our knowledge, among the monitoring systems employed by social media companies, WeChat's surveillance system is the only system that monitors content sent by one set of users to enhance the surveillance and censorship of another set. How do these findings add to our understanding of digital censorship in China?

What is WeChat & how does it work?

Originally developed as a chat app, the WeChat platform has grown to support voice calls, "Moments" social media posts, and file sharing. Specific to China, the app also serves as a major payment and financial transaction platform. Globally, the app also supports Mini Programs, which are a key feature relied on by a majority of WeChat users.

Does WeChat have a third-party tracking ecosystem?

Another report investigated the third-party tracking ecosystem across 52 commonly used Mini Programs, found that many shared user data with third parties, and generally provided unsatisfactory notice and opt-outs to users. Since the CNCERT report, WeChat has attempted to tighten user data controls within its Mini Program ecosystem.
