What did the 124th Division do?

The 124th Division was a division of the PRC People's Liberation Army. During the Korean War, it was the first unit of the People's Republic of China to cross the Yalu River.

What is the difference between 124th & 125th Army?

The 124th is transferred to the PLA 72nd Group Army (formerly 1st Group Army) under the Eastern Theater Command; the 125th is still part of the PLA 42nd Group Army, which is currently known as the 74th Group Army, under the Southern Theater Command. It is now an amphibious mechanised unit.

What did the 124th Division do in the Korean War?

The 124th Division was a military formation of the People's Volunteer Army (Chinese People's Volunteers (CPV) or Chinese Communist Forces (CCF)) during the Korean War with a standard strength of approximately 10,000 men. It was a component of the 42nd Army, consisting of the 370th, 371st, and 372nd Regiments.

What was the 125th Division?

This division and 125th division defeated ROK 8th division on November 26, then 125th was deployed as vanguard, and 124th division was its reinforce. In April 2017, The division was divided into two brigades: the 124th Amphibious Combined Arms Brigade and the 125th Amphibious Combined Arms Brigade.

When was the 7th Division formed?

The 7th Division was formed during September and very early October 1914, by the bringing together of regular army units from various garrison stations around the British Empire. They were assembled in the New Forest in Hampshire before initially moving to Belgium.

When was the 7th Australian Infantry Division formed?

The 7th Australian Infantry Division was the second formation to be formed in the 2nd AIF. It initially had the 20th and 21st Australian Infantry Brigades, formed respectively in May and July 1940. Both brigades were sent to the Middle East in October 1940.
