Yes. That's backward compatible, according to GM. You can also use Valvoline Dex/Merc, Supertech Mercon-V, Supertech Dexron VI, Castrol TransMax Import multi-vehicle ATF, Valvoline Maxlife, etc that are suitable for Dex II/III applications.

So I need some help because I'm currently having some power steering leaks in my Toyota Solara 2003 2.4L 2AZ-FE engine with automatic transmission and 215k miles. At first it was a leak from a fluid line on the rack and pinion.
