What happens if my battery gets punctured? **DO NOT INTENTIONALLY PUNCTURE A BATTERY.** A puncture can cause the battery to swell, vent gas, or catch fire. If you have a punctured battery, store it in a fireproof container in a well-ventilated area. The gas that these batteries give off if punctured is toxic and flammable.
