Where can I recycle a used battery?

EPA recommendation: send used alkaline and zinc carbon batteries to battery recycler or check with your local or state solid waste authority. These small, round batteries have historically contained silver, cadmium, mercury or other heavy metals as their main component. Today, the majority are made of lithium metal.

Can you recycle car batteries?

How much does it cost to recycle a battery?

The WeRecycle Battery Box, which range in price from \$44.95 to \$115.95, is another solution for recycling a large amount of batteries. Call2Recycle, a nonprofit that leads rechargeable battery recycling programs recently started offering mail-in single-use battery recycling that cost between \$68 and \$3,80 for an entire pallet of used batteries.
