Should I wire my furrion RV backup camera to my RV battery?

If you do end up wiring your Furrion RV backup camera to your RV battery make sure you keep an eye on the battery levels. The camera doesn't use a lot of power but every watt adds up over time and small things can drain a battery quicker than you might think.

Can a furrion RV backup camera be used as a security camera?

All of the Furrion RV cameras have motion sensors that will wake up the display when they detect movement. They also have infrared night vision and microphones so you can see and hear what's going on at all times. There's one little catch to using any RV backup camera as a security camera, the power supply.

Does the furrion Vision s have a pre-wire kit?

The Furriion Vision S Wireless RV Backup Cameras like part # FOS05TASF are activated by the running light circuit so you would need to have your running lights on to activate the camera. However, I have heard that some pre-wired systems have the backup camera wired to a constant power source so they could monitor the outside while they were camping.

We also just purchased a Wildwood X-Lite and ordered the Furriion backup wireless observation camera and it did not match up either. Called the dealer and forest river main support line and they said the Wildwood X-Lite is wired and mounted for the&quot;Drive&quot; CL-718W-C 7&quot; TFT LCD (16:9) Wireless Rearview Backup Camera System&quot;.

verified that the Camera works. No matter what I turn on, marker lights, rear lights, etc. I have no power to the pre-wired connector.

I am trying to install a Furrion backup camera in the shark fin that came prewired from the Jayco Factory. From what I have read here it's pretty much just plug the camera in, hook up truck to trailer, and turn the lights on. I have done all this and cannot get power to the camera to pair with my monitor. Suggestions would be greatly appreciated .

Re: Furrion Pre wired backup camera I'd start with the pre-wired connection at the camera base to see if there is power. You could use a second vehicle or 12v power source to plug monitor in to check on the too long a distance, but doubt that is the problem. It really sounds like a trailer wiring issue.

The Furrion Vision S Wireless RV Backup Camera Systems; part # FOS43TASF for 4.3" screen or part # FOS05TASF for 5" screen, are going to be powered by either the running or backup light circuit. If you don't have the running or backup lights activated, then this would indicate why you don't have power to the camera.

Maybe there is a workaround. I got a tiny WIFI backup Camera from Amazon. Took off the center rear marker light, wired it to that light (positive and negative) filed a tiny round hole in the bottom for the wire, and then slipped the backup camera metal foot/mount under the light, screwed it all down, and then siliconed it up, re-sealing the light also.

I previously had returned a D5 package because the holes didn't line up with the DoHonest wireless camera bracket. For my application, this was a much better option when adding the DoHonest back up camera to my RV, which has ...

In the meantime, the switch is close to the junction box where your battery power and several wires for the TT roll through it. I found the wire the feeds the camera circuit, (is part of the running light circuit) and spliced into that.
