Where is the Beijing Fengtai railway station?

The Beijing Fengtai railway station, which is located at Zhengyang Avenue, in the Fengtai District of southern Beijing, in China, is ready for opening after undergoing reconstruction. The Fengtai station was opened in 1898 as a small passenger and freight transportation railway station.

What is Fengtai Station?

With these services, Fengtai Station will be an important new transport intersection and the largest of Beijing's three intercity railway stations. At peak times it is expected that up to 20,000 passengers will use the station to arrive, depart or change trains.

How many railway lines are there in Fengtai Station?

The conventional railway lines with 20 tracks are at level 0, and two underground lines are at the level below. With these services, Fengtai Station will be an important new transport intersection and the largest of Beijing's three intercity railway stations.

Why is Fengtai Station a photovoltaic power station?

"The unique design has changed the layout of the traditional railway station. It is an innovative way to arrange the functions of a railway station," he added. One of those unique features is a photovoltaic power station on the roof, which generates power for the building. The original Fengtai Station closed in 2010.

What happened to the old Fengtai railway station?

The old Fengtai Railway Station was at the cross section of several important old railway lines, and provided services for passengers and freight. Zhou Wei, deputy head of the China Railway Museum's Zhengyangmen Exhibition Hall, told Xinhua News Agency. The old station closed in 2010, and the expansion project began in 2018.

Who built Beijing Fengtai railway station?

The station redesign and renovation were undertaken after the completion of the main structure. China Railway Engineering Corporation (CREC), a state-owned company, was responsible for the construction of the rebuilt Beijing Fengtai railway station.

The station has 12 platforms for high-speed trains (consisting of 6 islands) directly above 20 platforms for conventional services (consisting of 9 islands and 2 side platforms). Fengtai railway station is served by Line 10 and Line 16 of the Beijing Subway. Both the line 10 and line 16 stations have underground island platforms. The s...

The rebuilt Fengtai Railway Station in Beijing inched closer to re-opening after a test train was flagged off from the station early Tuesday. The reconstruction of the station began in mid-2018. It covers an area of
